GO Sports has also created a business centre for lease by private business or sport organizations, community rooms for use by sport groups and community organizations, dance and yoga studios, equipment rentals and is developing community outreach programs providing no-cost usage to various youth and community groups.


Ortona Gymnastics Club

The facility has 236,000 square feet of recreational space and is the first of its kind built in Canada. It also has the largest hardwood floor installation in the country.




Spectator Gym

The Saville Community Sports Centre is the home of the University of Alberta Golden Bears and Pandas basketball and volleyball programs. This 2,800 seat facility will host Canada's most successful CIS basketball and volleyball events, each with a long history of student, alumni, and community support in Edmonton. The Spectator Gym will be the host of many other large events due to its unique design and the environment it creates for fans and athletes.


North Sports Hall

These courts are utilized by recreational leagues, drop-ins, high school programs, and competitive leagues.




Fitness Studio



Boardroom (2)



Complete with extensive branding components, your business will be positioned to reach key demographics and lifestyles in an unparalleled environment from across the entire marketplace.





Walking Track


The two lane running/walking track located on the second floor overlooking the Spectator Gym is a highly utilized amenity in our facility.

Electronic Wayfinding Units
